TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE MAIN CONCERT

The present terms and conditions were issued in accordance with the articles of Mass Events Safety Act published on March 20th, 2009, consolidated text, Journal of Laws of 2015 pos.2139. and in accordance with the articles of Civil Code.

1. The host of the event is Association of Student Parliament from Cracow University of Economics; henceforth known as the Host.
2. The host is responsible for the event proceeding in according to terms and conditions.
3. Participants present at the Cracow University of Economics campus area are obliged to the legislation order of the facility. **Entry to the campus area leads to their immediate and absolute acceptance.**
4. Entry to the event is granted for people above 18 years old with a valid ticket and an student ID card/other ID document depending on the ticket type.
5. In the case of missing document for a discount, it's necessary to pay the additional fee.
6. After the exit from the event area, the ticket loses its validity.
7. It is forbidden to bring into the event area: liquid beverages especially alcohol, weapons and dangerous materials which include: explosives, pyrotechnic materials, strongly corrosive substances, drugs, psychotropic substances and any other items which could endanger other people's safety in the event area. Additionally it is forbidden to bring in not bigger bag than personal handbag with dimensions not larger than 42x32x25 cm.
8. Personnel of the guard service are entitled to carry out personal search on the people entering in order to prevent any attempts of bringing in any forbidden objects listed in paragraph 7. In case of suspicion that people entering the club area are bringing into or possess prohibited things described in paragraph 7, will be ask by the members of guarding service to leave the Event.
9. People not meeting the requirements set in paragraph 4 will not be allowed entry into the event area, additionally people being under influence of alcohol, drugs, acting aggressively, possessing forbidden objects listed in paragraph 7 under the terms of the main concert as well as not responding to cloth and bag search, those for who the penalty was imposed as bans on access to mass events and other justified cases will not be allowed entry on the main concert area.
10. People present at the Campus of the Cracow University of Economics during the Event are obliged to follow some instructions given by the Host and personnel of the guard service, who are responsible for security and safety. In these cases the people will be ask by members of guarding service to leave the Event.
11. Personnel of the guard service are allowed to apply measures of direct coercions, in accordance with principles described in applicable regulations concerning protection of people and property, as well as regulations concerning surroundings and conditions of using.
12. At the Campus is absolutely prohibited the possession and consumption of the alcoholic beverages. The exception are separated and enclosed catering areas, where the purchase and consumption of low-level alcoholic drinks will be allowed.
13. To people, who do not respect the above said prohibition, is applied the Regulation of the Minister of the Interior of 11th of the May 1983 on rules and procedures in case of bringing in the alcoholic beverages on the areas encompassed by prohibition of bringing in alcoholic beverages (Journal of Law of 12th May 1983).
14. All over the Campus is non-smoking zone, except the areas designed by the Host.
15. All people, who are damaging property, disturbing the Event proceeding, creating a threat to human life or safety will be refrain from staying in the area where the mass event is taking place, made by the personnel of security service in aim to transfer to the Police.

16. The Host reserves the right to cancel the event or changes to the event proceeding for reasonable grounds (illness of artist, canceled arrival of artist, force majeure etc.), in addition the right to establish and change the schedule in frame of time and artistic terms.
 - a) The Host is not responsible for the effects of force majeure. The force majeure is considered as circumstances, which are out of control of the Host and prevent the Host from fulfilling a contract or lead to consider liabilities as unobtainable under existing circumstances.
 - b) The force majeure in particular is represented by weather conditions, failures or disturbances of devices delivering electricity, heating, light; wars, action of the State or regional governments in terms of policy, rights and regulations impacting on fulfilling the contracts.
 - c) Purchased ticket shall not be a subject of return or exchange. The Host is not obliged to pay any reimbursement or indemnity to ticket owner, except for the reimbursement representing the price for the ticket, of the same sum of money as price, for cancellation of the Event.
17. All forms of professional audiovisual recording of performances are prohibited (the prohibition does not apply to people authorised by the Host).
18. The Host also records the Event proceeding in order to documenting and promoting or advertising the Event and events in following years, the Host and sponsors. The portrayal of people present at the area of the Event can be recorded and published for documental, reporting, advertising and promoting purposes.
19. In the area of the event there is forbidden:
 - a) to enter with animals,
 - b) to enter with bicycles, rollerblades, skateboards and other similar vehicles,
 - c) to do any commercial or marketing activity, door to door selling or collection without permission of the Host,
 - d) to climb or go through buildings and other destined to do so objects (e.g. fences, walls, trees, masts, poles, roofs),
 - e) to enter areas not designed for participants (e. g. backstage, internal rooms, staff rooms),
 - f) to dispose of physiological needs outside the toilets,
 - g) to litter the area of event.
20. The participants are obliged to follow ordinances given by the Host, the Police, the Fire Brigade, presenter and the guard service.
21. The host do not take any responsibility for any damages, injuries, thefts and material losses created by other participants.
22. This set of terms and conditions is available in the Host's headquarters, on web page www.juwenaliauek.pl and during event at information and by the entrance of the event.
23. In cases unsettled in the terms and conditions, regulations of articles of Mass Events Safety Act and Civil Code apply.
24. In case of damaging possessions used during the concert are applied regulations from the Decree of Minister of the Interior and Administration of 31st July 2009 regarding to procedure of fixing damages created in connection with actions in place and during the mass event and procedure of compensations (Journal of Laws of 3rd September 2009).
25. Condition of maintaining order and safety or participants and equipment users is abiding by this set of terms and conditions, regulations of penal law and law of offences.
26. In cases unsettled by this Terms, concerning fire safety, apply regulations contractual from the Act of fire safety measures.
27. The right of interpretation and changes of this set of terms and conditions is reserved by the Host.

The Host informs that items of all kind and vehicles placed on the escape route or obstructing conducting the possible rescue operation will be removed at the owner's expense.

The participants can be exposed to continuous stay in the area of sounds capable of causing hearing damage and effect of glittering light or some of its natural combinations capable of causing loss of consciousness or epileptic seizure.
