

The Statute of the Event

„The Main Concert – Juwenalia CUE 2019”

§ 1 General Provisions

1. The present statute – later referred to as „The Statute” published by the Host and refers to the entertainment and artistic mass event called „The Main Concert - Juwenalia CUE 2019” in the form of a concert, belonging to the category of mass events with the meaning of art. 3, regulation from 20th of March 2009 about the safety during the mass (Dz. U. 2015 r., poz. 2139) – later called „The Event” and organized on the premises of the Republic of Poland, according to the binding rules of the Polish law – including the civil code.
2. The Association of the Student Parliament of the Cracow University of Economics is the main Host of the event, later called as „The Host”.
3. The event will take place on the premises of the Cracow University of Economics (address: Rakowicka 27, 31-510 Kraków)
4. Entrance and staying on the premises, and during the Event are paid for on the basis of the valid and binding tickets, invitations and accreditations.
5. Each person staying on the premises, and during the is required to follow the rules of this Statute.
6. The Host through his representatives and subservient services has a right to refuse the entrance on the premises of the Event to the intoxicated people, indicating being under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other narcotics or even remove them from the premises of the Event in case of such emergency.
7. The Host is not liable for the things left on the premises of the Event.
8. The goal of the Statue is to ensure the safety of the Event through determining the rules of entrance and the conditions of taking part in the Event, as well as the conditions of behavior of the people present at the Event and their use of the area, on which the Event is being held, as well as devices located on it. In addition, the Statute regulates the rights and obligations of the Participants of the Event in connection with the purchase of an admission ticket to the Event.
9. The following terms used in the Regulations will have the following meaning:
 - a. "Ticket" means an individual consent to enter the Event, which at the first entrance to the Area of the Event is subject to verification, both in the paper form (ticket purchased stationary) as well as in the form of a code (ticket purchased electronically).
 - b. "Area of the Event" means the designated part of the Campus of the Cracow University of Economics, where the event is being held.
 - c. "Event Participant" means a person participating in the Event on the basis of purchased Ticket.
 - d. "Security Services" and "Information Services" means the people designated by the Host, including employees of the agency protecting people or property, to care for the safety of people participating in the Event, including control entitling the Participants of the Event to enter the Area of the Event.

§ 2

TICKET SALE

1. Tickets are sold only at the authorized points of sale, and through the website.
2. The Host informs that in accordance with art. 133 of the Act of May 20, 1971. Code of misdemeanors: "He who acquires tickets for resale with profit from artistic, entertainment or sporting events or who sells such tickets from profitable, subject to arrest, restriction of liberty or a fine. Attempt and incitement or aiding are punishable. "
3. The Host warns that buying the tickets from the third party involves the risk of buying a falsified ticket, which can result in the refusal of the ticket and the entrance to the event.
4. In the case when a Participant with a disability needs help of a supporting person, the entrance for that person is included in the price of the Ticket and that person is free to enter the event. This permission applies only in case of people supporting those with a significant degree of disability, as well moving on wheelchairs with any degree of disability. The degree of disability referred to above should be confirmed by the decision of the County Adjudication Team of Disability (along with a document with a confirmation photo and identity) or a valid ID card (along with a document with photo confirming identity).
5. Purchased ticket shall not be a subject of return or exchange. The Host is not obliged to pay any reimbursement or indemnity to ticket owner, except for the reimbursement representing the price for the ticket, of the same sum of money as price, for cancellation of the Event.

§ 3

ENTRANCE TO THE EVENT

1. The adults that have a Ticket, along with a valid student ID or identity card, depending on the type ticket are allowed to enter the Area of the Event.
2. In case of the absence of a document entitling to a discount, a surcharge must be paid.
3. After leaving the Area of the Event, the Ticket expires.
4. It is forbidden to bring to the Area of the Event:
 - a) beverages (in particular alcoholic beverages) and food,
 - b) weapons and dangerous items, including: explosives, pyrotechnics, caustic substances, intoxicants and psychotropic substances and any objects that may pose a threat to people staying on the premises of the event.
 - c) devices that record images (camera, camera, drone).
 - d) Bringing animals to the Area of the Event
 - e) baggage larger than hand baggage with a maximum size of 42 x 32 x 25 cm
5. Security Services have the right to search people entering in order to prevent bringing prohibited articles to the event mentioned in point 5. In case of suspicion that people are bringing in or have prohibited items as specified in point 5, will be called by Order Services to leave the mass event.
- 6 Evaluating items and qualifying them as dangerous belongs to Hosts and subordinate departments.
7. People who do not meet the requirements will not be admitted to the Area of the Event specified in point 1, as well as being under the influence of alcohol, means intoxicated people, behaving aggressively, possessing prohibited articles referred to in point 4 of these Regulations, refusing to submit to control clothing and luggage, as well as against whom a

penalty was banned from entering mass events and other legitimate reasons. In that cases these persons will be ordered by the Security Service to leave the Area Events.

§ 4

ORGANIZATIONAL RULES APPLICABLE IN THE AREA OF THE EVENT

1. The organizer ensures the safety of persons present at the Event and order during the Event, by, among others:
 - a) Security Services and Information Services;
 - b) appointing a Coordinator for security issues, managing the Service Order and organizing the work of these Services;
 - c) providing medical assistance and sanitary facilities;
2. The organizer ensures fire safety by ensuring that:
 - a) service staff, Security and Information Services and the Organizer they must know the location of handheld firefighting equipment and hydrants and rules of conduct in case of fire;
 - b) Security and Information Services must be trained in:
The principles of conducting evacuation, how to alert the Fire Brigade, rules for the use of hand-held firefighting equipment, first medical aid.
3. The things that are prohibited In the Area of the Event:
 - a) all professional audiovisual recording, including by means of unmanned aerial vehicles, of the artistic performances taking place (does not apply to people with appropriate accreditation issued by the Host).
 - b) conducting any commercial or advertising activity, and collection of cash collections without consent of the Host,
 - c) entering or passing through buildings and equipment no intended for general use (e.g. fences, walls, trees, masts, posts, roofs),
 - d) entering areas that are not intended for viewers (e.g. facilities stages, interior rooms, work rooms),
 - e) dealing with physiological needs outside toilets,
 - f) littering the Area of the Event
4. Participants of the Event staying at the Event venue are obliged comply with the orders of the Hosts and Security Service, caring for safety and order.
5. Order Services may use coercive measures, from compliance with the rules set out in the applicable laws regarding protection of persons and property and in the provisions regarding conditions and manner use of direct coercion measures by employees.
6. Participants of the Event and all other people who are on the Site of the Event are obliged to behave in a non-threatening manner to ensure the safety of other people present at the Event, and in particular to comply with the Regulations. It is forbidden to destroy the equipment located at the Event venue.
7. Participants of the Event destroying property, disturbing the course of the Event, posing a threat to life or health will be removed from the Event Area by Order Services in order to hand them over the Police.
8. Security Services are entitled in accordance with the provisions of the Act to:
 - a) check the right to stay at the Event Venue, and in case of determination of the lack of such rights - a call to leave the Area of the Event;

- b) legitimize the Participants of the Event in order to establish their identity, browsing the contents of the luggage, clothing of people, in case of suspicion that these persons bring or possess items referred to in § 3 point 4.
 - c) issue order messages to people disturbing the order public or acting in violation of the regulations of the Event, and if they do not follow these instructions, call them to leave the Event;
 - d) use in cases referred to in art. 11 points 1 and 2 of the Act of 24 May 2013 on measures of direct coercion and firearms (Journal of Laws Pos. 628), direct coercion measures referred to in art. 12 para. 1 point 1 lit. a and b, point 2 lit. a and point 12 lit. and this law;
 - e) to put up persons in order to promptly hand them over to the Police and immediate threat to human life or health, as well protected property.
9. The Hosts are not responsible for damages, injuries and thefts as well as material losses resulting from the actions of the Participants of the Event.
10. The Host provided a deposit, 10 zlotys per piece. The only items that will be accepted in are included in the deposit regulations.
11. In the mass event, consumption of alcohol is allowed low-percentage up to 3.5%, which can be purchased in separate catering zones. Purchase and consumption of low-grade alcohol above 3.5% is possible only in the closed catering area outside the Area of the Event.
12. There is a total ban on smoking outside the special zone in the area of the Event appointed by the Host.
13. During the Event, the Host and Participants of the Event, as well as other people staying on its premises, undertake to comply with the provisions of the Act on education in sobriety and counteracting alcoholism.

§ 5

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANTS

1. The Host informs that due to the large number of Participants of the Event and the necessary control and security measures to be taken at the entrance to The Area of the Event, Participants of the Event are obliged to come to the Area Events in advance.
2. The Host informs that the Participant of the Event or other person staying at the Area of the Event will be still in the loud noises zone, that may damage your hearing. During the Event there will be used also strobe lights.
3. The Host also records the course of the Event for the purpose of documentation and promotion or advertising of the Event in future years, the Host and partners. The image of people staying at the Event venue can be recorded and then distributed for documentary purposes, reporting, advertising and promotional. The participant who does not consent to the publication of his image has submit in writing a statement to the address weronika.leja@juwenaliauek.pl in accordance with art. 81 The Act of February 4th, 1994 on copyright and related rights (i.e. OJ 1994 No. 24 item 83 with later d.)
4. It is forbidden to conduct any activity in the Area of the Event that involves advertising, marketing, promotion not previously agreed with the Host. People who violate this prohibition will be removed from the Area of the Event. The Host will not be obliged to pay any compensation against the holder of a ticket not complying with the prohibition.

§ 6

THE FINAL PROVISIONS

1. This set of terms and conditions is available:

- a) on the webpage www.juwenaliauek.pl
 - b) at the information desks at the Area of the Event
 - c) by the entrance of the event;
2. The Host reserves the right to cancel the event or changes to the event proceeding for reasonable grounds (illness of artist, canceled arrival of artist, force majeure etc.). In addition he also has the right to establish and change the schedule in frame of time and artistic terms.
3. The Host is not responsible for the effects of force majeure. The force majeure is considered as circumstances, which are out of control of the Host and prevent the Host from fulfilling a contract or lead to consider liabilities as unobtainable under existing circumstances. The force majeure in particular is represented by weather conditions, failures or disturbances of devices delivering electricity, heating, light; wars, action of the State or regional governments in terms of policy, rights and regulations impacting on fulfilling the contracts.
4. The participants are obliged to follow ordinances given by the Host, the Police, the Fire Brigade, presenter and the guard services).
5. In cases unsettled in the terms and conditions, regulations of articles of Mass Events Safety Act and Civil Code apply.
6. In case of damaging possessions used during the concert are applied regulations from the Decree of Minister of the Interior and Administration of 31st July 2009 regarding to procedure of fixing damages created in connection with actions in place and during the mass event and procedure of compensations (Journal of Laws of 3rd September 2009).
7. Condition of maintaining order and safety of participants and equipment users is abiding by this set of terms and conditions, regulations of penal law and law of offences.
8. All forms of professional audiovisual recording of performances are prohibited (the prohibition does not apply to people authorized by the Host). The Host also records the Event proceeding in order to documenting and promoting or advertising the Event and events in following years, the Host and sponsors. The portrayal of people present at the area of the Event can be recorded and published for documental, reporting, advertising and promoting purposes.
9. In cases unsettled by this Terms, concerning fire safety, apply regulations contractual from the Act of fire safety measures.
10. The right of interpretation and changes of this set of terms and conditions is reserved by the Host.
11. The Host informs that items of all kind and vehicles placed on the escape route or obstructing conducting the possible rescue operation will be removed at the owner's expense.
12. The participants can be exposed to continuous stay in the area of sounds capable of causing hearing damage and effect of glittering light or some of its natural combinations capable of causing loss of consciousness or epileptic seizure.
