

The Statute - The Wrestle of the Departments

1. The organizers of The Struggles of the Departments CUE 2019 consist of:
 - a. The Board of Juwenalia CUE 2019, st. Rakowicka 27, 31-510 Cracow,
represented by Aleksandra Zanic,
 - b. The Students Parliament of the Cracow University of Economics.
 - c. People designed on the behalf of the above-mentioned organizers to watch over the whole process connected with organizing the Wrestle:

2. The statue determines rules of the Wrestle of Departments, hereinafter referred to as, The Wrestle.
3. The Wrestle take place on the 8th May 2019 on premises of the Campus of the Cracow University of Economics.

§2

1. Both workers and students of the Cracow University of Economics can take part in the Wrestle.
2. Each department of the University of Economics has their own team.
3. The teams consist of 7 students and 1 worker of the CUE.
4. The recruitment for students lasts from 20th of March till 24th of April 2019.
5. The recruitment for students takes place through the online application form to which there will be a link, both on the website of the whole event, as well as on the Facebook Fanpage on the day of the commencement of the recruitment process.

6. Applying will be also possible through the paper application form, which will be available on the promotional stands of The Wrestle of Departments.

7. The workers, who take part in the Wrestle are chosen by the Coordinator.

8. One student can send just one application form.

9. Students who qualified to take part in the event will be informed about it via electronic mail.

§ 3

1. The teams take part in the competitions prepared and carried out by the organizers mentioned in §1 act 1.

2. The teams are evaluated by the Jury, whose members will be revealed after the completion of the online recruitment process.

3. The specific mode, rules and the way of evaluating the competitors will be specified in the statute published after the completion of recruitment.

§ 4

1. The organizer is not liable for all the damage caused due to not following the hereby Statute, its rules and the statute mentioned in w §3 art. 3.

2. Participation in the Wrestle of Departments is equivalent with the permission of the participant for the free use of his image by the Organizer for the records, advertising and promoting.

3. The Organizer is not liable for any harm or injuries caused during the event.

4. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify of the team or a team member without giving a reason.

5. In the matters unsettled in this Statute the Organizers have the casting vote.

6. The Organizer is not liable for any kind of thefts during this event.

7. The Organizer reserves the right to change and interpretation of this Statute.

§ 5

1. Personal data of the participants will be processed by the Organizer only to carry out the Wrestle, according to the hereby Statute throughout the period of duration of the Wrestle (on the basis of article 6 act 1, GDPR);

2. Personal data of the participants will be processed according to the resolution of the law from the 10th of May 2018 about the personal data protection (Dz.U. 2018 poz. 1000 z późn. zm.) and Regulation of the European Parliament and Council

Regulation of European Parliament and Council (EU) 2016/679 from 27th of April of 2016 about protection of natural persons connected with personal data processing and about free movement of data, and reversal of directive 95/46/WE (the general regulation about the personal data protection "GDPR").

3. The participants have the right to access the content of their data, and to their correction, removal, restriction of processing, the right to cancel their permission at any given moment without influencing the correspondence with the law of processing, which was done on the basis of the permission before its cancellation.

4. Sending the application by the participant is equivalent to accepting the whole Statute and its rules by the participant.
