

Terms & Condition - Faculty Competitions

I. Basic Provisions

1. The Host of The Faculty Competitions - Juwenalia CUE 2019 is:
 - a. The committee of the Juwenalia CUE 2019, Rakowicka 27, 31-510 Cracow represented by Aleksandra Zanik,
 - b. Students Parliament University of Economics, Rakowicka 27, 31-510 Cracow, later referred to as the Host.
 - c. On behalf of The Host for the appropriate event proceeding related to organising The Faculty Competitions - Juwenalia CUE 2019 project are responsible as follows: The Coordinator Maria Bartkowska and the selected members and supporters of Students Parliament: Przemysław Szot, Bartosz Kościółek, Joanna Trzeciak, Artur Piotrowicz, Julia Mrozowska, Jakub Łyczko and Gabriela Waclawik, later referred as Project Team.
2. Terms and Condition set rules to The Faculty Competition, late referred as Competitions.
3. Competitions are held on 8th May 2019 in CUE Campus.

II. Teams

1. Employees and students of CUE are able to take part in Competitions.
2. Each faculty of CUE have their own team.
3. Teams are consisted of 7 students and 1 employee of CUE.
4. Students may apply between 20th March and 17th April 2019.
5. Applying for students is able trough electronic form, which will be shared on event page and fan page on Facebook in first day of enrollment.
6. Applying is also possible by paper form available on Faculty Competitions stands.
7. Employees taking part in Competitions are chosen by Coordinator
8. One student can fill one form.
9. Students which were chosen for representing their faculty will be informed about further procedures via email.

III. Rules of Competitions

1. Teams take part in competitions prepared and conducted by the Host.
2. Teams are judged by the Jury, whose composition will be given for information after completion of the recruitment process by electronic means.
3. The detailed procedure, rules and manner in which competition will be assessed will be set out in separate regulations published on completion of the recruitment process.

IV. Ending Provisions

1. The Organiser shall not be liable for any damage caused by failure by participants to comply with these Regulations and the Regulations, referred to in §3 section 3.
2. Participation in The Faculty Competition is also agreement for free use of personal image by the Host, in terms of documentation, advertising and promotion.
3. The Host does not take responsibility for any injuries and wounds taken during the event.
4. The organizer reserves the right to disqualify a team or a player without giving reason.
5. In matters not regulated by these Terms & Condition, final decision is Hosts.
6. The Host does not take responsibility for any items stolen during event.
7. The Host reserves the right to change and interpret these Terms & Condition.
8. Personal data of participants will be processed by the Host exclusively for the following purposes the implementation of The Faculty Competitions, in accordance with with these Terms & Condition for the duration of the Competition (pursuant to Art. 6 act 1 of RODO)
9. Participants data will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the Act of 10 May 2018 on the protection of personal data (Journal of Laws 2018 it.1000, as amended) and regulation of the European Parliament and the Council of 27 April 2016/679 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation "RODO").
10. Participants shall have the right to access their data and the right to rectificate, erase, restrict of process, withdraw of consent at any time without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing of which was made on the basis of consent prior to its revocation.

11. Sending by the Participant an application under the Tournament is unambiguous with acceptance of the Regulations by the Participant.
